Heating remains one of the NHS's largest carbon and cost challenges, accounting for over 60% of energy use across acute and community estates. Yet for many Trusts, wholesale HVAC replacement is neither affordable nor feasible.

This session shares results from the ecosync × NHS Solent decarbonisation programme, demonstrating how existing wet-radiator systems can be transformed into intelligent, low-carbon networks through AI-driven heating

control and IoT smart-valve optimisation. Deployed across multiple NHS Solent sites, ecosync's maintenance-free and battery-free LoRaWAN valve actuators have delivered up to 45–50% reductions in heating energy waste, improved patient and staff comfort, and provided real-time Scope 1 carbon visibility to support SECR and Net Zero planning. Crucially, ecosync also provides AI-automated annual carbon reporting, aligned with emerging NHS and government decarbonisation disclosure requirements — giving estates team instant, auditable ESG data at the push of a button

The 10 Year Health Plan seeks to transform the NHS into a neighbourhood health service through delivery of the three shifts: from hospital to community, sickness to prevention and from analogue to digital. The plan makes a clear statement that neighbourhood provision starts with making the best use of existing and underutilised public assets. Through existing NHS LIFT buildings, access to capital investment, and the ability to deliver at pace, Community Health Partnerships (CHP) is

well positioned to support the delivery of a nationwide Neighbourhood Health Service.

In this presentation, CHP will share how we are working with national and local teams to identify and repurpose existing estate to support the left shift and bring more services closer to local communities. We'll also highlight a live example where this approach is being rapidly implemented. We will provide a first look into a new tool – PACE (Productivity Acceleration in Community Estates) Plan, and how this data led approach is supporting ICBs in making informed decisions through the use of strategic and operational information.

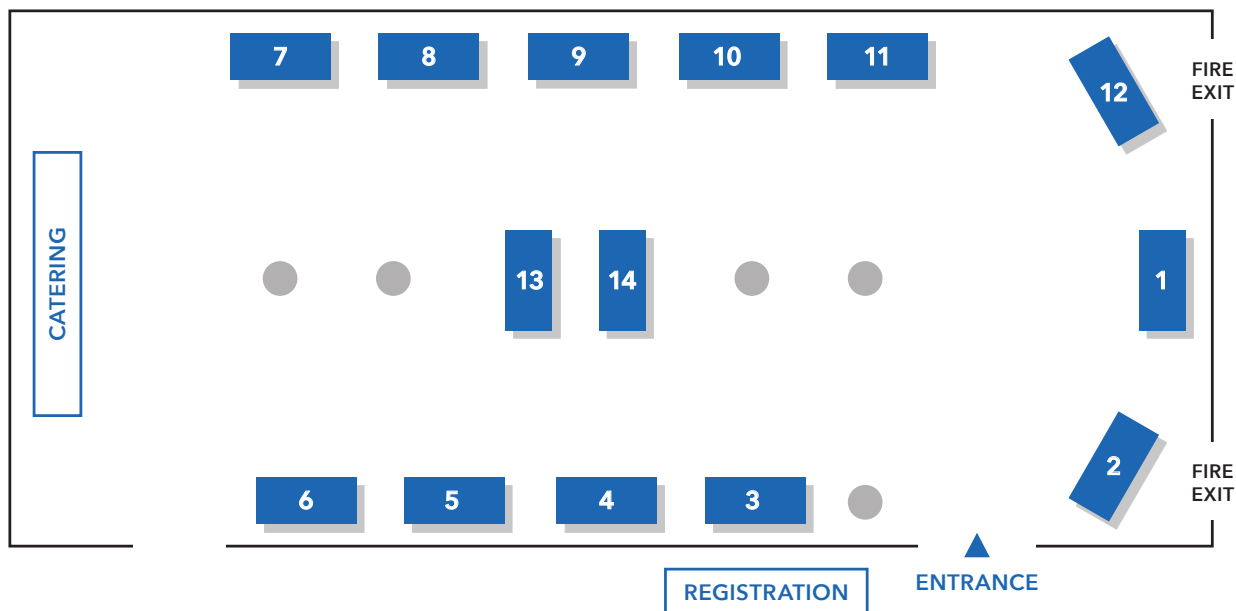
